April Vacation: Center for Wildlife

On April 28th at 10am, we will be visited by the Center for Wildlife, based in York, Maine! The program will be in person, at the library! We'll be talking about seasonal adaptations in animals: Native wildlife have amazing adaptations they use to survive extreme cold, heat, wind and other elements. With assistance from our live, non-releasable raptor, reptile and mammal ambassadors, we will examine the special tools for surviving the New England seasons such as an owl's feathered talons or hibernation and migration. Educators will focus on seasonal wildlife and their adaptations as well as tips on spotting and helping local wildlife.








Furnace Replacement Project

In December, one of the library's three furnaces died. As these furnaces are in the ceiling of the library, replacing them is no small feat. On April 11 & 12, the library will be CLOSED. Curbside, however, will be open those two days. On April 13, the library will open only for limited browsing and curbside, all to give the replacement team ample space to work.

The Board of Trustees have decided to replace two of the three furnaces from a normal propane propelled heating and cooling unit to an electric heat pump. This will allow our heating and cooling to be more efficient, and environmentally friendly as they will be using electricity from our solar panels instead of propane.
